1. APOLOGIES

3.1 **Bridge Safety**

Ian and John had visited Danbury Lakes where they spoke to a warden who informed them that ECC self-insure up to £1.2m and yet they are quite happy to use chicken wire as a non-slip surface on wooden bridges similar to ours.

There was some discussion regarding options for the bridge and it was agreed that John should draft a response and circulate for comment.
